Born and raised in Michigan, Tom was one of eight kids. As most young boys, Tom quickly became interested in cars. His family owned a company called Yochum Auto Supply, and Tom and his brothers spent most of their free time racing cars on a local quarter mile dirt track.

When Tom was 6 years old, family life quickly became difficult. Tom's father passed away leaving his family of 9 behind, the youngest sibling at the time was just nine months old. Shortly thereafter, the family business was shut down by the state for Estate taxes. Tom's mom, known affectionately as the "Iron Lady", went to war with the State and was successful in reopening the business to support the family once again.

At age 20, Tom joined the army and spent two years with the 82nd airborne at Fort Bragg. Upon completion of his service, he met and married Penny and they decided to move to Winter Haven, Florida. Once there, he started working for Christ Auto Parts.

Tom then decided to change careers. He went into the financial service industry and was hired as a teller at the Florida National Bank in Bartow. While there he pursued his undergraduate degree, which in order to accomplish, required Tom & his family move to Orlando. His pastor wrote letters of recommendation to two bank presidents in Orlando and Tom was hired by Barnett Bank in Winter Park. While working days, he was able to finish his degree at the Hamilton Holt School at Rollins College.

Tom worked 28 years for the Barnett Bank system and was actively involved in more than thirty bank acquisitions and consolidations during that time eventually becoming CEO of the central Florida local affiliate.

In 1998, Barnett Bank was sold. Tom joined Sun Trust Bank of Central Florida as its CEO. He retired from Sun Trust Bank in 2004 and associated with the Lowndes Law Firm for the next 13 years. While working with the Lowndes Law Firm, he helped start a new bank, Seaside National Bank and Trust where he served as Chairman of the Board before retiring in 2019. In all, Tom worked in the Florida financial services industry for over 50 years.

In addition to the great work Tom has done in the financial industry, even more impressive is the work he has done in the community. The Orlando Business Journal published a story about how Tom raised over \$100 million dollars for various nonprofit organizations in the central Florida community.

ORLANDO POLICE DEPARTMENT

COURAGE - PRIDE - COMMITMENT

Minimum Qualifications

- Must be at least 21 years of age to apply.
- Must be a U.S. Citizen.
- Must possess a High School Diploma or equivalent.
- No dishonorable discharge from any branch of the military.
- Valid driver's license for at least 1 year from date of application with a good driving record.
- No felony convictions.
- No misdemeanor convictions involving moral character, false statements, or domestic violence.
- No pending criminal charges.
- No illicit drug use for the past 3 years. Other drug history will be scrutinized on a case by case basis.
- Excellent moral character.
- Vision correctable to 20/40 in each eye.
- All employees hired after October 1, 2005 must reside within thirty-five (35) miles radius of the intersection of Central Boulevard and Orange Avenue, Orlando, Florida 32801. Those hired prior to that date shall live within thirty-five (35) miles or 45 minutes of that intersection.



Pre-Employment Process

The hiring process takes approximately 6 months. Successful applicants must complete the following steps:

- Pre-Application - Police Officer
- Police Officer Application
- Civil Service Exam
- Physical Assessment
- CJBAT
- Panel Interview
- Polygraph Examination
- Background Investigation
- Interview with the Chief of Police
- Post Offer Polygraph Examination
- Medical Examination
- Psychological Examination
- Post Physical Agility Test






Our council collected **310,000** pounds of food, which provided **258,310** meals to families throughout Central Florida as part of Scouting for Food.
